# *Akrasia* and Elegy

*Odi et amo*: hating and loving simultaneously is just one of many instances in Roman love poetry of a 'weakness of will' known in ancient ethics as *akrasia*. This contribution presents some preliminary research towards a view that Latin elegy offers a philosophically inflected meditation on this issue, and more broadly on the degree to which the individual is in charge of their emotions, decisions and, ultimately, their destiny.
