If your score is a number followed by an "*", this means that your 'theory' score is less than 18 but your overall score (the average of theory + practice) is a pass (i.e. you have passed the whole exam).

If your score is F*, this means that your 'theory' score is less than 18 and that your overall score (the average of theory + practice) is also less than 18 so you will have to retake the 'theory' part (as well as the 'practice' part if the 'practice' part is less than 18).

If your score is a number not followed by an “*”, then the score you see is your ‘theory’ score. This score will be averaged with your ‘practice’ score (when it becomes available) and if this average is 18 or above, then you will have passed the exam.
